SNSYC Junior Membership

Current Junior Members of SNSYC receive a \$25 discount off fees which are deducted at time of payment. Non-members may join the Sidney North Saanich Yacht Club by filling out an application and paying the Junior Membership Dues. Junior Membership will allow the Member to participate in Junior Program Activities throughout the year and Sunday and/or Thursday sailing sessions between April and October.

Procedure

Upon receiving the Summer Sailing School Application, it will be reviewed for completeness including receipt of payment. If accompanied by a Junior Membership Application form and receipt of Junior Membership Dues, the Summer Sailing School payments are discounted by \$25. Students will be contacted with further instructions.

Application Requirements

- Applicants should be between 8 and 18 years of age.
- Both the application form and payment must be received before the student's place in the course can be reserved.
- All students must pass the swim test held on the first day of class in order to be able to participate in the course.
- There is a Zero Tolerance policy for drugs, alcohol and cigarettes. If caught, students will be expelled from the course without refund.
- Poor behaviour; or behaviour which might jeopardize the safety of others, or negligent damage to the club facilities and boats, may be grounds for expulsion from the course without refund.
- Courses will not be extended because of lack of wind or poor weather.
- Students who wear glasses or expensive sunglasses must wear straps for them (e.g. *Croakies*).
- Please inform the Summer Sailing School Coordinator or Head Instructor if the student has learning difficulties, is hyper-active or has a history of behavior problems and advise what can be done to help.

Refund Policy

- Full refund of Sailing School tuition fees will be provided to those students who withdraw a minimum of two weeks prior to classes commencing; or at any time prior to classes commencing, if an alternate student is available to fill the vacancy created.
- A pro-rated refund, less \$50, will be provided to those students who must cease attendance after a course has commenced, because of unanticipated illness [upon receipt of certification by a doctor] or other extenuating circumstances such as family emergency, as deemed satisfactory to the SNSYC Executive.

Financial Assistance Application Criteria

- Letter of application for funding. Describe your child and how our program can help. Justify why the assistance is required.
- Second letter from teacher, friend or neighbor confirming why the child and family are suitable candidates.
- Mail to SNSYC labeled "Summer Sailing School Bursary Application".
